TOPIC 1: ALL ABOUT PIN LOOM WEAVING

TOPIC 3: THE LANGUAGE OF COLOR: INDIGENOUS DYING IN CHILE



1. Bias Weaving



TOPIC 1: BIAS WEAVING FROM SCRATCH

This class teaches four pattern stitches on square looms, creating textured, decorative designs. No prior knowledge is needed, making it perfect for beginners to learn pin loom weaving.



TOPIC 2: SQUARE, TRIANGLE & RECTANGLE LOOM

This bias pin loom weaving class explores weaving on square, triangle, and rectangle looms, teaching techniques to create patterns along the bias. Students learn to combine shapes and textures for unique, dimensional woven designs.



TOPIC 3: AMAZING JOINS FOR WOVEN PIECES

This class teaches four crochet techniques to join woven pieces seamlessly, transforming separate sections into polished, cohesive designs. Students learn creative joining methods to add decorative detail to their projects.



2. 4x4" Pin Loom Weaving



TOPIC 1: THE TWO AND THREE WARP METHODS

This 4x4" pin loom class teaches the two- and three-warp methods, guiding students to create versatile woven patterns. No prior experience is needed, making it ideal for beginners exploring pin loom weaving.



TOPIC 2: HOW TO DESIGN YOUR OWN PATTERNS FROM SCRATCH

This 4x4" creative class teaches how to design your own woven patterns from scratch using a unique method. Perfect for beginners, it guides you to unleash creativity and make personalized pin loom designs.



TOPIC 3: AMAZING JOINS FOR YOUR WOVEN PIECES

This class teaches creative ways to join woven pieces, making separate sections seamless and polished. Students learn techniques that add both strength and decorative flair.

TOPIC 1: OBJECTS & GARMENT CONSTRUCTION USING WOVEN PIECES

This class teaches how to turn individual woven pieces into wearable garments by joining them creatively. Students learn techniques for shaping, joining and assembling woven sections to create tops, scarves and other clothing items.



TOPIC 2: MIX & MATCH PIN LOOM PATTERNS

This class teaches how to creatively combine and layer pin loom patterns and stitches to make unique woven designs using different colors and thicknesses of yarn.



TOPIC 3: MAKE IT SHINE: EASY YARN COLOR MIXING

This class teaches how to combine yarn colors easily to create vibrant, eye-catching woven pieces. Students follow simple steps to mix hues and textures, making weaving fun and beginner-friendly.
