This 7th year, I invite you to join us in making your very own mini sweater (s) and help as reach our goal of 100 mini sweaters!

Come along, enjoy every step of the process, and be part of something truly special!

#### HOW TO PARTICIPATE

Grab your 4×4" pin loom (PerfectCouple, Zoom Loom, Weave-It) and start weaving your mini sweater! The only requirement is to make it using only 4 to 6 woven squares of size 4×4". You can use any wool composition you like, ideal yarn weight is DK or Worsted (N° 4). (Tip: Try using your leftovers!)

#### HOW TO MAKE A MINI SWEATER

No need to be a pin loom expert! Just follow the step-by-step instructions in the following pages and start creating your own mini sweaters.

#### HOW TO SEND YOUR DESIGNS

Place each mini sweater on a white sheet of paper and take a photo straight from above. Try to use natural daylight and send the image as a high-quality JPG file (minimum 150 dpi) to: florencia.campos@ullvuna.cl

\*\*\* Don't forget to mention your name, country and what inspired you to create your design.

#### DEADLINE

The last day to send your picture (s) is **December 18th**. On December 20th, the final big picture featuring all the mini sweaters will be published, along with an e-book showcasing every creation, its author, and the story behind it.

#### TAKING YOUR PICTURES

This is how you should take pictures of your sweaters (feel free to position the sleeves as you like).



#### BE CREATIVE!


Use your leftover yarn and experiment with different fibers, colors, textures, finishes, beads, appliqués, embroidery stitches, macramé, fabric and so much more.



## HOW TO MAKE A BASIC MINI SWEATER


1. Position the 4 woven squares as shown.



3. Fold down each sleeve and sew both sleeves and side edges of the sweater as shown.



2. Sew the lines in beige as shown.




Leave open a gap of 1" aprox in the middle (neckhole).


## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

To start sewing, notice that the side edges are different from the upper/lower edges of each square, therefore there are two ways of sewing edges:

- SEWING Upper and Lower edges: Cut 7" of yarn. Make a slip knot in one corner and then start sewing as shown below.



SEWING Right and Left edges:
Cut 7" of yarn. Make a slip knot in one corner and then start sewing as shown below.



# FIVE PIECES SWEATER IDEA

This is a "frac" version of the mini sweater using five woven pieces.

If you like it, follow the steps to make your own version.
